2. The allegations of the Complaint are well founded and the Complainants are entitled to relief.
3. The facts underlying this action do not warrant the appointment of Commissioners.

It is therefore ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

1. That the boundaries of the Central Charlotte County Drainage District as created by Order of the Circuit Court of the Twelfth Judicial Circuit in Case No. 5710 are hereby amended to include all of Section 2, the Eastern 3/4 of the North 1/2 of the North 1/2 of Section 10; the North 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 11; the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 11; the Western 1/4 of Section 12; the Eastern 1/2 of Section 14; and

the Eastern 1/2 of the Southwestern 1/4 of Section 14; all lying in Township 41 South, Range 23 East, Charlotte County, Florida.

2. The Court retains the jurisdiction necessary to enforce this Final Judgment.
