Minutes of June 10, 2015 Annual Meeting of Landowners & Supervisors of The Central Charlotte County Drainage District

The Annual Meeting of Landowners & Supervisors of The Central Charlotte County Drainage District was held on Wednesday, June 10, 2015, at the Charlotte County Public Works Building, 7000 Florida Street, Punta Gorda, Florida 33950. The President of the District, Mr. Robert "Bucky" McQueen, called the Meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. Roll was taken, and it was determined that all Supervisors of the District, being David Anthony (via telephone), Claude H. Collier, and Robert "Bucky" McQueen, were present at the Meeting. Also present at the Meeting were Jerry and Joyce Gillespie, landowners in the District, Jeanette Fowler, Secretary/Treasurer of the District, and Edward L. Wotitzky, Esq., attorney for the District.

Due and proper Notice of the Meeting was then established. The Notice of Meeting was published in the Charlotte Sun newspaper on May 29 and June 5, 2015. Attached to these Minutes is the Publisher's Affidavit of Publication which includes the Notice of Meeting.

The Minutes of the July 3, 2014 Annual Meeting of Landowners and Supervisors and the Minutes of the March 11, 2015 Workshop Meeting of Supervisors were then considered. After consideration, and on Motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the reading of the Minutes was waived and the said Minutes were approved as submitted.

The Landowners then proceeded to elect one (1) Supervisor. Mr. Wotitzky advised the term of David Anthony expires on September 30, 2015, and that an election for a Supervisor to fill that position was in order.

The floor was open for nominations. Mr. David Anthony was nominated to serve an additional three (3) year term. There were no further nominations, and on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, Mr. David Anthony was elected to serve as a Supervisor of the District for a three (3) year term commencing October 1, 2015. As a result of the election, the following individuals constitute the Supervisors of the District for the noted terms:

Name of Supervisor Date of Term Expiration

Robert "Bucky" McQueen - September 30, 2016
Claude H. Collier - September 30, 2017
David Anthony - September 30, 2018

The Supervisors then proceeded to elect officers for terms commencing on October 1, 2015. After discussion, and on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the following individuals were elected to the noted offices:

President - Robert "Bucky" McQueen

Vice President - David Anthony Secretary/Treasurer - David Anthony Jeanette Fowler The Financial Statements for the District were then presented and reviewed by Jeanette Fowler. Mrs. Fowler first reviewed the Statements of Expenses as compared to the Budgets for fiscal years ending September 30, 2013 and September 30, 2014. The said Expense Statements and Budgets are attached to these Minutes. Mrs. Fowler noted the expenses for fiscal year ending September 30, 2014 totaled \$9,550.50. It was noted the expenses did not include maintenance expenses, as the \$7,000.00 approved for ditch maintenance is in the process of being utilized.

Mr. McQueen advised that a certain degree of coordination is being accomplished with Charlotte County concerning the cleaning of ditches. Mr. McQueen reported the County is completing its maintenance and cleaning of the ditches along Grove Boulevard, Westminster, and State Road 74. Mr. McQueen also reported he has coordinated with the Water's Edge RV Resort the District maintenance projects.

Mrs. Gillespie then inquired as to whether Charlotte County is performing maintenance to some of the ditches within the Central Charlotte County Drainage District. Mr. McQueen advised the County is conducting some cleaning work in ditches which are used jointly by the District and by the County for the Charlotte Ranchettes MSBU. Mrs. Gillespie expressed concern regarding possible prescriptive rights the County could assert with respect to some of the Central Charlotte County Drainage District ditches for which the County is maintaining. Her concern was based on her loss of property abutting State Road 74 on which the County maintained drainage ditch is located.

Thereupon, Mrs. Fowler continued her Financial Report. She advised that as of May 31, 2015 the total funds of the District equal \$50,041.44. Attached to these Minutes is a copy of the May, 2015 Bank of America bank statement for the District.

Mrs. Fowler then presented the Budget for fiscal year commencing October 1, 2015. The proposed Budget would require an acreage assessment of \$14.00 per acre, which is consistent with the current revenues collected by the District. A copy of the proposed Budget is attached to these Minutes. After further discussion, and on motion by Claude H. Collier, seconded by David Anthony, and unanimously carried, it was

RESOLVED, that the proposed Budget, a copy of which is attached to these Minutes, for fiscal year commencing October 1, 2015, be, and the same is hereby approved and adopted. It was further

RESOLVED, that assessments be levied at the rate of \$14.00 per acre for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2015.

The Supervisors and Landowners then considered maintenance projects. The Board of Supervisors ratified the prior actions taken with respect to the cleaning of various ditches at a cost not to exceed \$7,000.00. Mr. McQueen, as President of the District, was authorized to contract with Lake Doctors or another contractor to perform ditch and canal maintenance work of the District.

The District's attorney was then called upon. Mr. Wotitzky first advised that pursuant to an Amendment to Chapter 189 of the Florida Statutes, each Special District is required to have an Internet Website containing certain information by October 1, 2015. Mr. Wotitzky reviewed the

website information which he had prepared. A website developer will be contacted for purpose of developing and compiling the website.	the
Mr. Wotitzky also advised that pursuant to Section 189.08 of the Florida Statutes, e independent Special District is required to submit a Public Facilities Report to the local generation government in which the District is located. Mr. Wotitzky noted a Report has be prepared. After further discussion, and on motion made by Claude H. Collier, seconded David Anthony, and unanimously carried, it was	eral een

RESOLVED that the Public Facilities Report be approved and that the President of the Board, Mr. Robert "Bucky" McQueen, be, and he was duly authorized to execute the Report on behalf of the District.

There being no further business before the Landowners and Supervisors, the Meeting was, on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, adjourned.
